- 7:00 p.m. Torch Run, Opening Ceremonies and Cauldron Lighting at the Lake Placid Olympic Center.

DAY TWO

- 9am-4pm Skiing & Snowboarding at Whiteface, the greatest vertical drop east of the Rockies awaits everyone in your family. If it's your first time, our trademarked "Parallel From the Start" and "Burton Learn to Ride" program will have you competing to end your morning lesson! For all those who are ready the mountain is yours to explore at your own pace.
