



Whiteface Mountain Uphill Guidelines 2018-2019

- I understand that uphill skiing is not permitted during daytime lift operations.
- I understand that that uphill skiing starts no earlier than 6AM and ends at 8:30AM or when the lifts are open for downhill skiers. There is no climbing between the hours of 8:30AM and 6:00AM the next day. Whiteface reserves the right to close the ski area to uphill traffic without advanced notice (Check website for earlier closing notice).
- I will check in at Medical Services Area (Ski Patrol) before ascending every morning.
- I will adhere to uphill daily uphill instructions, all rules and regulations set forth in the skier's responsibility code and Safety in Skiing Code Rule 54 of the NYS Industrial Code Rules, and follow all instructions and directions of Whiteface employees.
- I understand that I can only use using skis or snowboards only. Foot traffic, sleds or other snow toys are not permitted.
- I understand that only designated routes for the day are open for uphill skiing (ascending and descending). All other routes and ski trails are considered closed.
- I understand that route signage signifies which side is for uphill travel and which side is for downhill travel.
- At check-in, I will confirm route and I understand that all other trails are closed to uphill and downhill skiing traffic.
- I am aware that snowmaking may be in progress and that grooming tractors and snowmobiles are actively travelling throughout the ski area.
- I understand that I should constantly aware of snow cats, winch cat cables, snowmobiles, ATVs, trucks, other skiers, riders and other exposures typical of an operating ski area and may be on the mountain.
- I will avoid groomers, snowmobiles, snowmaking equipment, and all other ongoing operations at the ski area.
- I understand that I must have an uphill season pass (Pass must be purchased before ascending, no exceptions).
- I understand that an uphill season pass can be purchased for \$25.00 and is valid from opening day to close of the lift serviced ski season. Season Pass holders must also hold this pass; it is included with purchase of the lift access season pass. The uphill pass does not provide Lift Access.
- Users are required I understand that I am to wear reflective clothing and a light that is visible from any direction.

- I understand that the pass should be visible and available upon request by any mountain employee while climbing or skiing. Uphill climbing without a pass may result in me being removed from the property.
- I understand that I may not cross a winch cable on a trail. If I come across a winch cable, I must turn around immediately and start descent to base lodge using return route.
- I understand that If I am asked by a Whiteface employee to leave an area, I must comply immediately.
- Other than Medical Services entrance and associated bathrooms, I will not enter any buildings.
- I understand that pets are not permitted at any time.
- Whiteface Mountain ski center has administrative use of the ski area land. Whiteface reserves the right to modify or terminate this program at any time.

I have read and understand the above and shall adhere at all times to these guidelines. The undersigned acknowledges and accepts the risk of uphill climbing and downhill skiing and agrees to hold harmless New York State and the Olympic Regional Development Authority from any injuries and other losses that may be incurred while participating in this activity.
